

***Béatrice BLOHORN-BRENNEUR***

A pioneer in the institutionalisation of Judicial mediation in France and in Europe (more than 1000 Mediations ordered as a Judge in labour, Family, civil and Commercial matters), Beatrice is currently one of the two mediators at the Council of Europe and an Honorary presiding Judge.

She is the founder of the European Association of Judges for Mediation GEMME-Europe (she served as the Vice-President of GEMME), and she is the founding President of the French section of - GEMME-France and of the International Conference of Mediation for Justice (CIMJ). She served as well as a Judge at the French Supreme Court. A graduate in Law and a PhD holder in civil and in criminal law, Beatrice is also a trainer and an author on Mediation, while she participates and organises conferences on mediation, such as the annual International Conference on Judicial Mediation.
